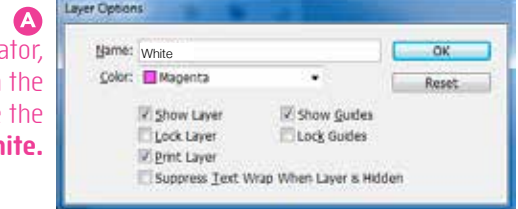

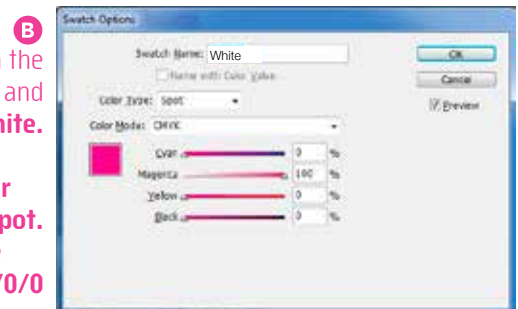
Setting up your files for white toner

Using white toner can give your documents a unique look that makes you stand out from the rest.

Setting up your document for printing with white toner

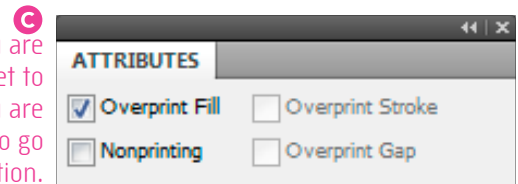


A In InDesign or Illustrator, add a new layer in the layers palette. Name the new layer **White**.

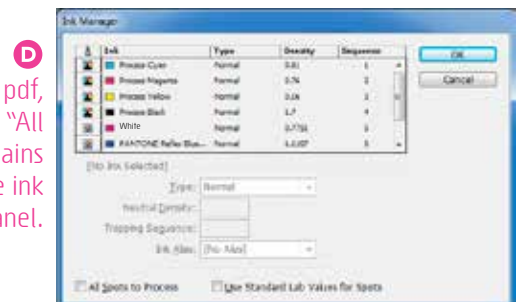


B Add a new colour in the swatches palette and name it **White**.

- a. Designate the **Colour Type** as **Spot**.
- b. Set the Colour Mode to **CMYK: 0/100/0/0**



C Have any objects you are printing in White set to overprint fill if you are wanting the white to go over a particular section.



D When exporting your pdf, make sure the tick box "All Spots to Process" remains unchecked in the ink manager panel.
